15/193	NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN 193.1 Councillor Shirley Shepherd welcomed David Kenworthy and Michael Clarke. David Kenworthy introduced Michael Clarke who presented an update of the current status of the Neighbourhood Plan. 193.2 It was AGREED that Easingwold Town Council RECOMMEND FOR APPROVAL at the next full council meeting on 15 th December 2015 the following actions: 1. Easingwold Town Council converts the draft Neighbourhood Plan into a Parish Plan. 2. Easingwold Town Council works closely with Hambleton District Council to influence the outcome of Hambleton District Council's emerging plan. 3. Easingwold Town Council meets with representatives of Yorkshire Water, Kyle and Ouse Drainage Board, local doctors, the Clinical Commissioning Group and NYCC to assess local infrastructure requirements. 4. The infrastructure requirements are communicated to Hambleton District Council to inform the new emerging plan and are included in the revised future Neighbourhood Plan. 5. The Town Council prepares a press release about its decision.
15/194	COMMUNICATIONS STRATEGY 194.1 Councillor Barnes presented a vision document for Easingwold Town Council. 194.2 It was AGREED that the Clerk should circulate the document to all councillors in advance of the meeting of the council on 15 th December as well as additional members of the public and to place the item on the next full council agenda.
